## RCFU CLUB FIELD RULES

**++++ALL FLIGHT OPERATIONS ARE TO BE CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ACADEMY  
OF MODEL AERONAUTICS NATIONAL SAFETY CODE++++  
EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2018**

1. PROOF OF CURRENT AMA MEMBERSHIP IS REQUIRED TO FLY. NO MEMBERSHIP – NO FLY. ALSO REQUIRED IS FAA REGISTRATION AND COMPLETION OF THE FAA "TRUST" EXAM.
2. EACH MEMBER SHOULD CARRY WITH THEM THEIR CURRENT MEMBERSHIP CARD. OTHER MEMBERS HAVE THE RIGHT TO QUESTION ANYONE'S CURRENT MEMBERSHIP STATUS.
3. NO 72 MHz TRANSMITTER SHALL BE TURNED ON WITHOUT FIRST SECURING THE PROPER FREQUENCY PIN. ON BUSY DAYS, THE PIN SHALL BE PROMPTLY RETURNED TO THE FREQUENCY CONTROL BOARD AFTER THE AIRCRAFT AND TRANSMITTER HAVE BEEN SHUTDOWN.
4. ALL STARTING AND RUNNING OF ENGINES MUST BE DONE AT THE DESIGNATED START-UP AREAS. NO TAXIING OF AIRCRAFT IN THE PIT AREA IS ALLOWED.
5. A GUEST MAY ONLY FLY UP TO THREE TIMES BEFORE MEMBERSHIP IS REQUIRED TO CONTINUE USE OF THE FLYING SITE. GUESTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A RCFU MEMBER. THIS DOES NOT APPLY TO GUESTS PARTICIPATING IN INVITATIONAL EVENTS.
6. ALL FLYING SHOULD TAKE PLACE BEYOND THE NORTH SIDE OF THE RUNWAY (CLOSEST TO EASTMAN RD). FLYING OVER THE RUNWAY SHOULD ONLY BE USED FOR EXECUTING LANDINGS AND TAKEOFFS, OR AS DESIGNATED BY THE EVENT DIRECTOR DURING A SCHEDULED EVENT.
7. NO ONE, INCLUDING PILOTS, IS TO STAND BEYOND THE SAFETY NETTING WHEN MORE THAN ONE AIRCRAFT IS AIRBORNE.
8. NO MORE THAN SIX AIRCRAFTS SHALL BE IN THE AIR AT ONE TIME.
9. CALL OUT YOUR INTENTIONS TO OTHER PILOTS DURING FLYING ("LANDING", "ON-THE RUNWAY", "DEAD-STICK", ETC...).
10. A DECLARED DEADSTICK AIRCRAFT SHALL HAVE IMMEDIATE PRIORITY FOR RUNWAY USE ALL OTHER AIRCRAFT SHALL CLEAR THE RUNWAY AREA.
11. NO INTOXICATING SUBSTANCES, INCLUDING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, ARE TO BE CONSUMED BY INDIVIDUALS INTENDING TO FLY.

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12. EACH MEMBER SHALL HAVE A FIRE EXTINGUISHER IN THEIR POSSESSION WHEN FLYING. THE FIRE EXTINGUISHER SHOULD BE RATED FOR A, B, AND C CLASS FIRES.

13. SMOKING IS NOT ALLOWED ON SITE OR IN THE PIT AREA. ALL SMOKING IS TO BE DONE INSIDE YOUR VEHICLE OR TRAILER. FAILURE TO COMPLY SHALL RESULT IN SUSPENSION FROM THE CLUB

14. NO DRONE, MULTI-ROTOR, FPV FLIGHT IS ALLOWED ON SITE PER RCFU AMA CLUB CHARTER.

15. DO TO POTENTIAL FIRE HAZARD, TURBINE AIRCRAFT ARE NOT PERMITTED TO OPERATE FROM MAY 1ST UNTIL THE 1ST FALL RAIN, USUALLY IN OCTOBER.

16. WINTER RULES-NO FLYING OR RUNNING OF ENGINES PRIOR TO 10:00 AM DURING DUCKING HUNTING SEASON (3RD WEEK OF OCTOBER THRU JANUARY 31ST). THIS IS MONITORED BY RCFU MEMBERSHIP AS WELL AS STANISLAUS COUNTY OFFICIALS. FAILURE TO COMPLY SHALL RESULT IN DISMISSAL FROM THE CLUB.

17. OVERNIGHT CAMPING IS ALLOWED ON SITE PROVIDING A RCFU MEMBER IS PRESENT CAMPERS MUST PAY THE APPROPRIATE CAMPING FEE TO THE COUNTY AT THE FRONT GATE OF THE PARK ENTRANCE IN AGREEMENT WITH OUR LEASE WITH STANISLAUS COUNTY.

18. ONLY DESIGNATED CLUB OFFICIALS SHALL COMMUNICATE WITH COUNTY OFFICIALS REGARDING ISSUES WITH THE FLYING SITE.

19. ALL CLUB MEMBERS MUST HAVE THEIR MEMBERSHIP CARD VISIBLE WHEN FLYING AT THE FIELD. THERE ARE LANYARDS AND ID PLASTIC CARD HOLDERS IN THE STORAGE SHEED FOR CLUB MEMBERS..

## FAA and TRUST Instructions

For first time applicants, you need to go to this link <https://faadronezone.faa.gov/#/> and click on the bottom **Register** button, that says **The Exception for Recreational Flyers**.

On the next page, you need to **Create an Account**. **Make sure you remember your ID and Password.**

After you create your account, you will receive an email to you to verify that you have created the account. Click on the link on your email to verify your account.

This should take you back to the **FAA** link and **LOGIN**.  
Then Login with your ID and Password. On the next page click on I Agree.

The next page may ask if you if you have taken your TRUST test. Click Yes. Click Next

When you come to the page that asks for your inventory. You may have to click on manage Device Inventory and the add a device.

This is how to answer the following Questions:

Then click on next or done

This should get you to the billing page. Fill out the information and the charge should be \$5.00 fee for a three-year license.

After your payment there will be a card with your registration number. Print the card for your records. The card needs to be in your possession when flying. **This number is to be applied to all your aircrafts.**

This is the link for the TRUST test. It is a no fail test and there are about twenty or so questions.

When you have the FAA registration and TRUST numbers, print the numbers for your records. Do not lose the TRUST number because the web site does not store that number. **Write in the FAA and TRUST number on the RCFU Application.**
